A Creative Paper Interactive paper-making tour departs every 45 minutes and participants can try their hand at making their own unique paper, or find out why roo poo and wombat scats make such great paper. At any time visitors can see artists working on site; including wood turners, print makers, paper artists, milliners, fibre artists, bead makers and many more.
