Put on trial in Hobart for 'Mutiny and Piracy', the four convicts are due to be hanged... BUT manage to wriggle out of it! The Ship That Never Was has been performed at The Richard Davey Amphitheatre by The Round Earth Company ever since 1994, making it the longest running play in Australia.
